President Doug Ramsey called the meeting to order.

Motion by Wade Cline; seconded by Robert Farrens to approve the agenda. Motion carries.

Wade Cline shared a devotion.

Motion by Chris Bowman; seconded by Nikki Icard to approve October 8, 2024 regular meeting minutes and the electronic vote on October 29, 2024. Motion carries.

Treasurers report was distributed. Motion by Guy Chapman; seconded by Robert Farrens to approve. Motion carries.

TEAM ASSIGNMENTS/REPORTS:

<u>Administration</u> - Doug Ramsey - No report.

<u>*Care*</u> – Taylor Payne – Veterans Day celebration coming up; Thanksgiving meals plan for 200 plates; sign-up sheets for volunteers are available at both services and Pastor Josh will add a message to the phone tree.

<u>Learn</u> – Nikki Icard – Brittany Greathouse and Brittany Mitchell have volunteered to oversee the kids Christmas program. More clarification is needed when to have Sunday School or not when there is an event being held between services. Pastor Josh will start announcing it.

Worship - Chris Jolly - No report.

<u>Share</u> – Chris Bowman – The Team is preparing "Welcome bags" for visitors. Ideas are coming together for a more welcoming space as you enter the service areas. Maybe move the Tree of Life to a different wall space. Work continues on the website and the outdoor sign. Purchases for the team need to come from line item #5323 Fellowship for 2025 and make a budget request line item for 2026.

Finance - Payton Boyles - No additional report.

<u>Rusha Austin Scholarship</u> - Angie Mooney - No report.

<u>Preschool</u> – John Adair – John reported on the progress the Preschool has made in his 2 years on council. They have established an annual fundraiser with "Breakfast with Santa", hired an additional assistant; gained 10 children; and increased their bank balance by 107%.

<u>Building & Grounds (BAG)</u> – Mason Frye – The Team met and has agreed that the next major project will be to start gathering bids for the updating of fellowship hall, ramp and stage area. Things to consider are type of flooring, and sound barriers.

Technology – Wade Cline – Installation of cameras will begin on November 16.

Cemetery – Robert Farrens & Guy Chapman – No report.

PASTOR'S REPORT:

Pastor Josh shared how the Synod Assembly will be different in May, 2025 with the retirement of the Bishop. He asked that the Bishop and those affected by his retirement would be kept in our prayers. He explained how his insurance will change with Kristi's new job. There are no plans to participate in the Christmas parade at this time. It is not in the best interest of our funds when the weather could be a factor like last year.

Pastor Josh has received numerous requests for sponsorship help from several organizations. Motion by Doug Ramsey; seconded by Chris Bowman to give \$500 to the ACHS Cheerleaders for their trip to the national competition. Motion carries. Friendship has 3 young ladies who participate in this event. Funds will come from line item #5327.

Lisa James has approximately 56 foster kids for the Angel Tree this year. He will talk to Carrie Head about the Rotary Backpack needs. Jason Icard was approached about Cabins for Christ for Western North Carolina. A thank you was received from Lutheridge for the gift of \$10,000. Ms. Glenn from Wittenburg Elementary School thanked the church for help with a Ministry Impact program to stop bullying and to be kind. Discipline is down by 70%.

OLD BUSINESS:

▶ Motion by John Adair; seconded by Payton Boyles to adjourn the congregational meeting on November 17, 2024 at 10:20 am, if still in session, to prepare for the 10:30 am service and reconvene on Sunday, November 24, 2024, at 9:15 am. Motion carries. Time and Talent sheets will be handed out at the meeting. Names on the ballot for council are in random order.

NEW BUSINESS:

► Motion by Guy Chapman; seconded by Mason Frye to approve the revisions to the Friendship Lutheran Preschool Board Policies and Responsibilities with the addition of the statement that the Board and the Director will meet <u>at least</u> annually. Motion carries.

► Motion by Chris Bowman; seconded by Wade Cline to renew the copier contract with Sharp for a 60-month period. Motion carries.

► Motion by Nikki Icard; seconded by Payton Boyles to approve the Preschool fundraiser request for "Breakfast with Santa". Motion carries.

► Motion by John Adair; seconded by Angie Mooney to present the staff with a year-end bonus of 2% of their salaries and \$50 each to Spencer and Montevious. The 2% comes to about one week's pay. Pastor Josh's is based on his salary only. Motion carries.

Thank you to outgoing council persons for their work the last 2 years.

There being no other business, the meeting adjourned with prayer.

Our next regular monthly meeting will be moved to Monday, December 9, 2024, at 6 pm. All outgoing council persons are asked to attend to convey Team information. Payton Boyles volunteered to share a devotion.
